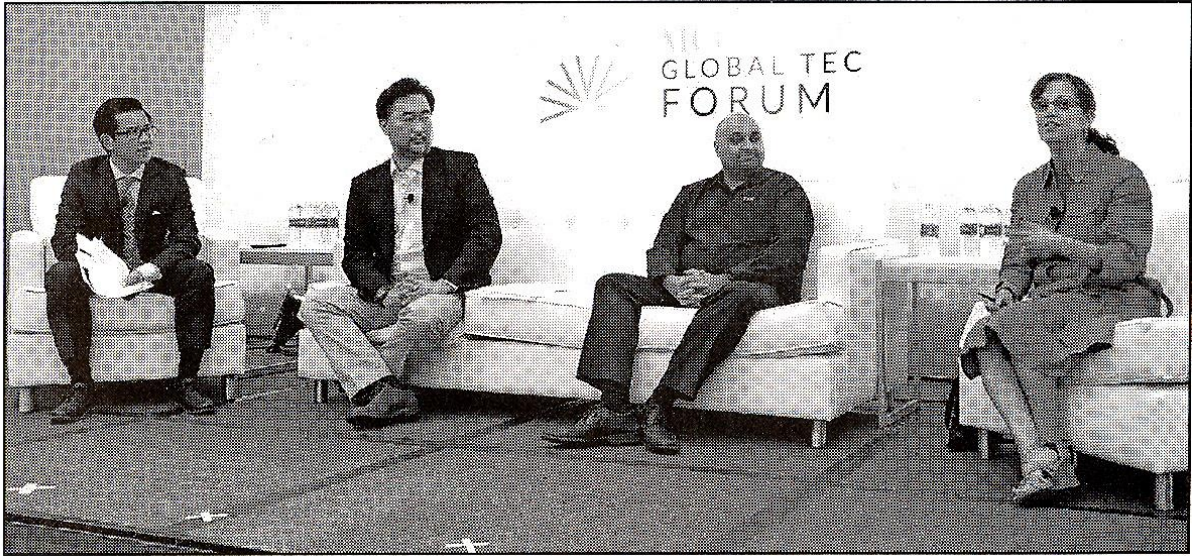

## AI discussed by Minority Corporate Counsel Association

**L**egalMation, a California-based technology startup, debuted a new artificial intelligence platform designed to help law firms by automating key tasks in the early stages of litigation, at the Minority Corporate Counsel Association's Global TEC Forum in San Francisco on Monday.

The AI platform, which is currently in beta testing with LTL Attorneys LLP, incorporates the computing capabilities of IBM Watson and generates draft work product, saving as many as 10 hours of attorney time.
